Early Bird Prize

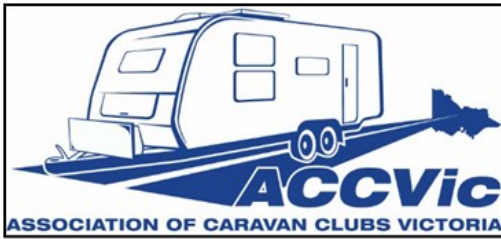
